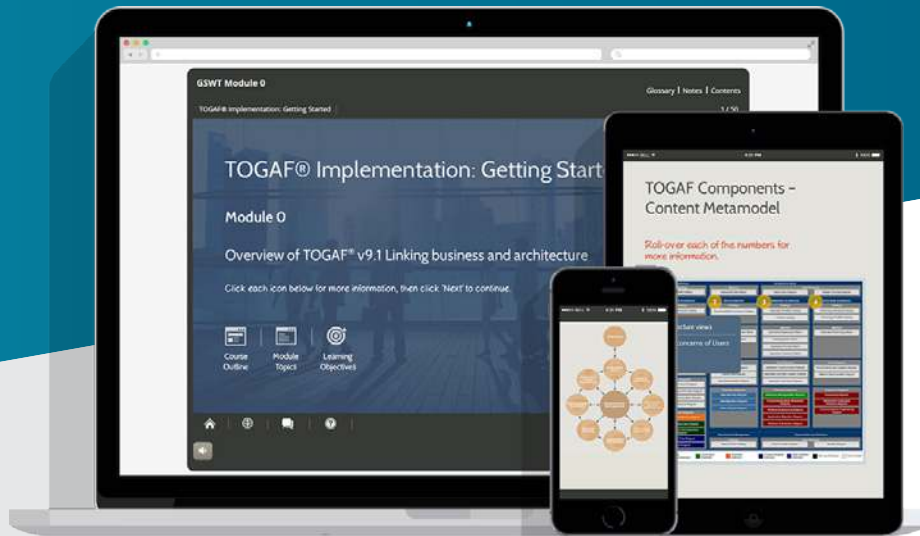

Establishing an Enterprise Architecture Practice can be a daunting challenge. In this course, experienced EA practitioners share their knowledge on how to get started with implementation.

Focusing on the Preliminary Phase, the course also looks at how to integrate TOGAF into the organization by setting up the correct structures, helping you begin implementation properly, and support the activities of the EA team successfully.

The course continues to look at EA demand and the motivation behind change, how we address these changes, the composition of these changes, and finally the delivery of change. It will also consider other frameworks, such as ITIL, and IT4IT.

The course contains an overview, followed by ten modules. A written exercise concludes each module.
